
## Reverend Father Edwin Richard Lapinski, C.R.

The Congregation of the Resurrection announces the death of Father Edwin Richard Lapinski, CR on August 4, 2021, at Columbia Forest Long Term Care, Waterloo. He was 95 years old, in his 76th year of religious life and 69th year of ordained priesthood.

Fr. Edwin professed his religious vows in the Congregation on August 15, 1945 in Chicago, Illinois, and was ordained to the ministerial priesthood on June 7, 1952 in St. Louis, MO.

He has ministered as Associate Pastor and as Pastor in numerous parishes in Ontario and Illinois. From Nov. 24, 1968 to Oct.1, 1977,



Father Lapinski served as Pastor at Sacred Heart Parish in Kitchener. During these years, Father Lapinski instituted some changes in Masses and devotions which took place after Second Vatican Council. The main change is that Masses are said in the mother tongue. On weekdays, he introduced Masses and a Novena to Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Polish.

After serving at our parish Fr. Edwin was moved to United States and from 1995 Fr. Lapinski was transferred again to Sacred Heart Parish as a Pastor Emeritus, until he retired to Resurrection Manor, Waterloo in 2008. As a Retired Priest, he was actively involved in Domestic Church movement.

A man of deep faith, hope and love. Father Edwin's life of faithful service touched the lives of his parishioners, brother religious, and family during his life of dedicated ministry. Even with ever decreasing eyesight, Fr. Edwin continued to actively reach out to his past parishioners ministering to their needs.
